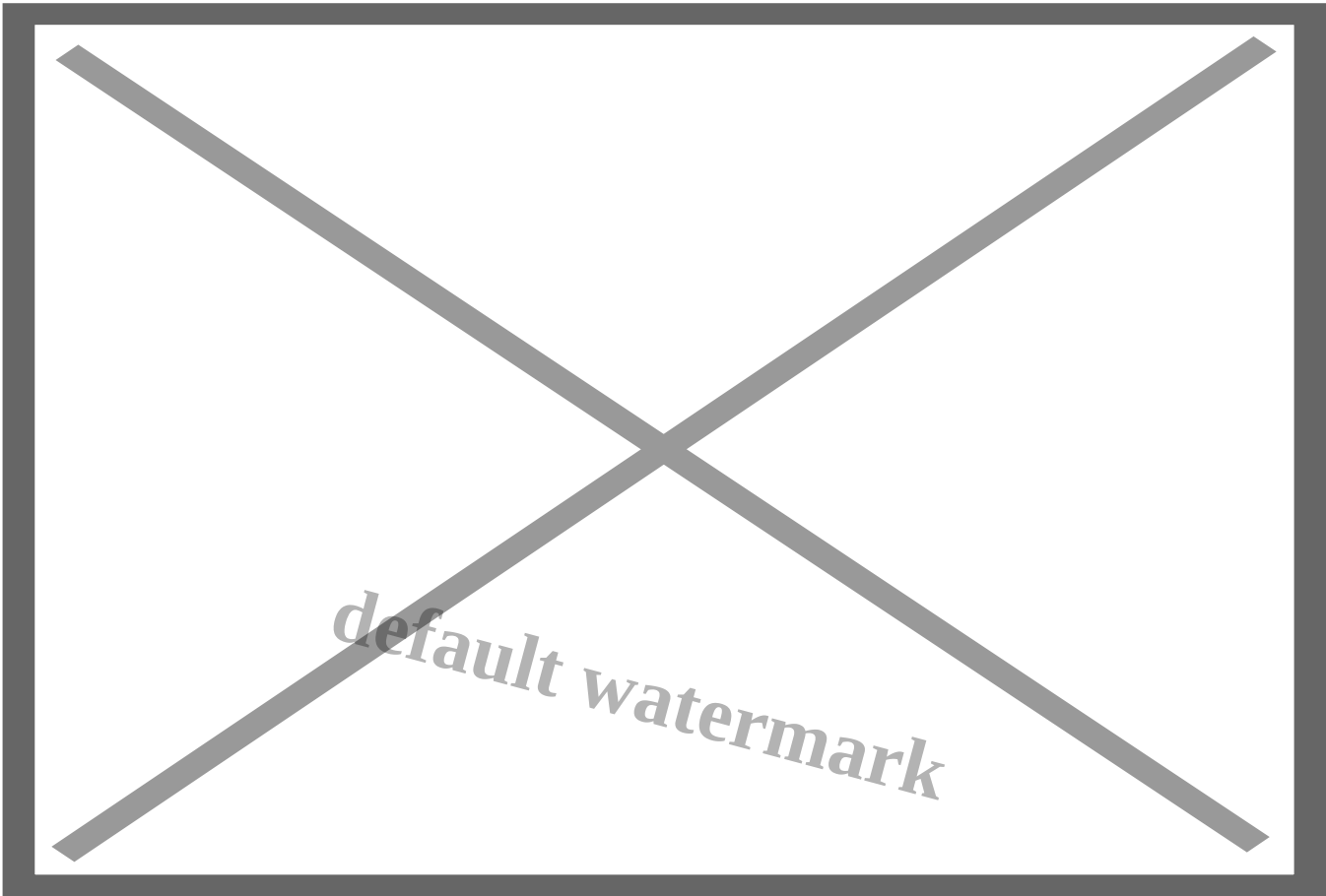
HYDERABAD (MediaBoss Network):
