Vangaveeti Narendra - Son of Vangaveeti Ranga

His appointment would be a major political move to strengthen TDP's presence in Krishna, Guntur, and Godavari districts, where Ranga has a strong support base.

Nagendra Babu - From the Jana Sena quota

A seat is expected to be allocated to Nagendra Babu, representing the Kapu community under the Jana Sena quota.
BC Category MLC Seat

The remaining one MLC seat is confirmed to go to a BC (Backward Class) leader, as Chandrababu's political strategy always includes strong representation for the BC community.
