Amaravati : Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu launched the Jai Dwarka Campaign at the state secretariat. He praised the remarkable research by renowned historian Ravindrajith, which was conducted under the guidance of ITS 6TH WOW. The research highlights the underwater ancient city of Dwarka, once a capital city of the world.
